# SERVICE INFORMATION

## **8am Holy Communion**

A quiet said service of Holy Communion using Common Worship including teaching and prayer. On the last Sunday of the month the service uses language from The Book of Common Prayer.

## **10am First Sunday All Together Worship**

A family-friendly, non-Eucharistic service where all generations worship together. Music is mainly led by a group, with organ as needed. Services may include testimonies, interviews, and prayers/readings led by all ages. Once a quarter, it's followed by a bring-and-share lunch.

## **6.30pm Taizé service**

This is a reflective service with candles, chants and singing, contemplative prayer and silence. A small music group lead the singing. On occasions this service may have a specific prayer focus.

## **10am Holy Communion**

A traditional Holy Communion service with robed choir, combining ancient and modern hymns and anthems. Children leave for junior church after the first hymn and return later to share in Communion and share what they've been doing.

## **10am Family Communion**

A shorter communion service for all ages using more contemporary language and fewer hymns. The choir lead the singing which may also include other musicians. There may also be baptisms at this service.

## **10am café church with breakfast**

Held four times a year in St Ed's coffee area, this café-style service starts with a light breakfast and includes singing, teaching, and creative or interactive prayers and activities. Sometimes we share an agape communion meal.

## **6:30pm Holden Service**

A short contemplative service with a small group of musicians and members of the choir leading music and liturgy.

## **6:30pm PRAY 4**

Focused prayer service - both together and in groups - lifting up different needs within the church and community.
